| Pristine | August | Good tasting, early, yellow | Eating |
| Jersey Mac | August | The first good sweet eating apple | Eating and baking |
| Akane | August | Good eating, tart, crisp | Eating, pies and sauce |
| Paulared | Mid August | Firm crisp, mildly tart | Eating, pies and sauce |
| Milton | Mid August- Sept | High quality, firm, tart | Eating, great pies and sauce |
| Ginger Gold | August - Sept | Greenish yellow, crisp, sprightly | Eating |
| Zestar | Late August | Sweet/tart great flavor | Eating, slices |
| Gala | Sept - Feb | Sweet, firm, high quality | Eating, salads |
| Mollies Delicious | Early Sept | Sweet, very large | Eating |
| Burgundy | September | Tartest of all and hard | Eating, salads, and pies |
| Jonamac | September | Crisp, juicy, high quality, tender skin, sweet | Eating, salads, pies, sauces |
| Honeycrisp | Sept - Dec | Very crisp, juicy, high quality, tender skin, sweet, unique texture | Eating |
| Elstar | Sept- Oct | Tart, and flavorful | Eating or cooking |
| 20oz Pippen | Mid Sept | Very tart, large and green | Cooking or baking |
| Cortland | Mid Sept- Jan | White, tender flesh, flesh does not brown, makes a pink sauce | Eating, holds slice: cooking, pies, sauces |
| McIntosh | Sept to Feb | Juicy, tender, mildly tart, Favorite "all purpose apple" | Eating, salads, sauces, pies. |
| Cardinal | Sept - Nov | Jonathan type, tart, flesh does not brown, similar to Melrose and Jonagold | Great Eating, and salas |
| Daybreak Fuji | October | Sweet hard | Great, eating |
| Jonathan | Oct - Dec | Spicy tart apple | For chunky pies or baking. |
| Jonagold | Oct - March | Flavorful high quality apple with tender skin | Eating, salads, baking and sauce, and pies. |
| Red Delicious | Oct - Apr | Red, sweet, juicy apple. | Good for firm eating and salads |
| Honeygold | Late Sept - Oct | Early Golden Delicious type apple | Good for eating and salads |
| Spartan | Late Sept - Oct | Crisp, juicy, sweet apple | Holds slice: eating, salads, pies and baking. |
| NY414 | Oct | Early Macoun type, very similar just about a week earlier | Eating |
| Macoun | Oct - Dec | A crispy, very tender and juicy apple, flavorful. Unique sweet-tart flavor One of the highest quality eating apples. Distinctive purple color | Eating sauce and baking |
| Northern Spy | Mid Oct - Dec | Hard, tart apple. | Traditional pie, cooking, eating. |
| Melrose | Oct - Apr | Attractive red apple with yellow back ground. Crisp, juicy, firm, tasty, good keeping apple. Great all purpose apple. "The Ohio Apple" | Eating, salads, sauces, pies, and baking. |
| Golden Delicious | Mid Oct - May | Yellow - high quality, tender and sweet | Great for eating, pies, baking and sauces |
| Old Fashion Delicious | Mid Oct - Dec | Slightly lighter red but sweeter than Red Delicious | Eating and salads |
| Mutsu | Mid Oct - May | Large, green, crisp, sweet/tart high quality | Eating, salads, pies, baking and sauces |
| Holiday | Dec - March | Crisp, high quality, thin skinned, similar to macoun | Great for eating |
| Empire | Oct - Apr | Firm, high quality, smallest sweet apple | Eating, salads |
| Topaz | Mid October | Tart thin skin, great texture and flavor | Eating and baking |
| Crimson Crisp | Mid October | Tart and hard great flavor | Eating |
| Stayman Winesap | Late Oct - Apr | A hard tart apple, dense skin and flesh | Good eating and baking |
| Granny Smith | Nov | Hard, green and tart | Good for pies |
| Fuji | December - May | Hard juicy and sweet | Excellent for eating |
| Goldrush | November - May | Hard and sour, yellow, small | Eating |
| Cameo | December | Hard and sweet | Eating |
